

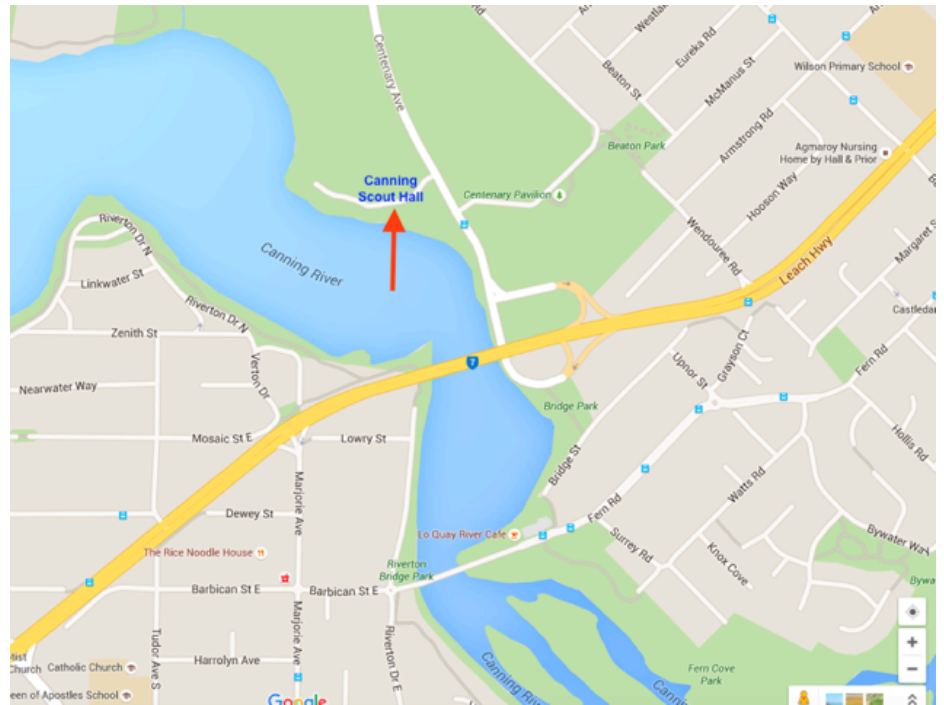
Canning Sea Scout Hall

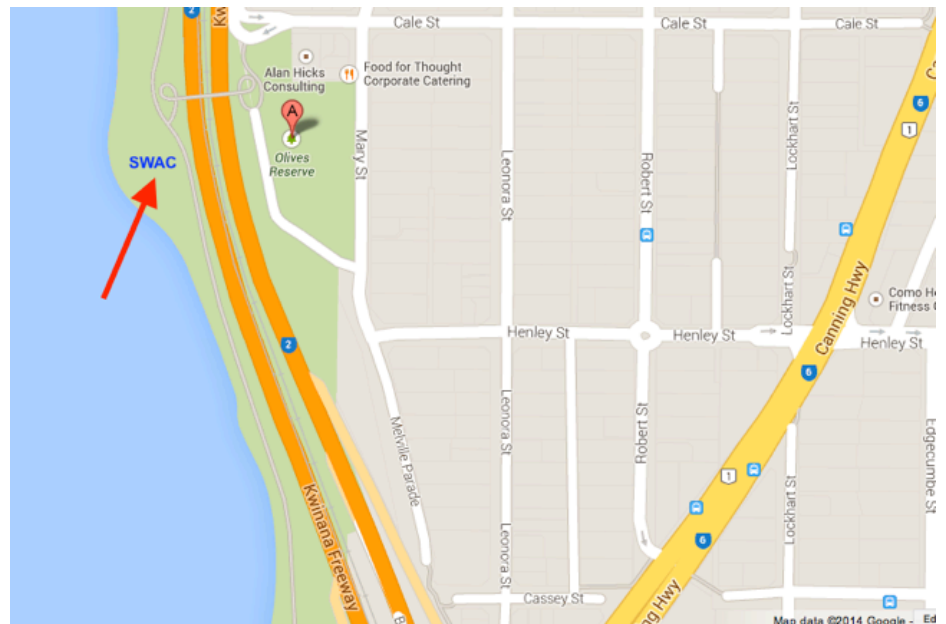


Scout Water Activity Centre (SWAC) Como Foreshore (opposite Olives Reserve)



SWAC is located on the river near Canning Bridge, on the western side of the freeway, within walking distance to bus/train terminals, adjacent to the Freeway bike path in a top riverside location.

Established in 2000, it was previously the Como Sea Scout Hall.

- barbecues
- areas for tents
- hot water showers
- tables, benches, fridges,
- inside hall sleeping available, with hammocks and some single bunks/beds (for leaders)

There are regular visits by dolphins and other wildlife as well as great bird watching opportunities
